**Evaluation Rubric for Annotated Bibliography**

<b>Criteria</b>	<b>Inadequate — 65%</b>	<b>Below Average — 75%</b>	<b>Above Average — 85%</b>	<b>Exemplary — 100%</b>
<b>Quality of Sources – 15%</b>	<i>Sources do not meet guidelines for types of sources used</i>	<i>Sources meet guidelines for types selected but there is no consideration of validity used throughout essay.</i>	<i>Several sources are credible but others are not current or have questionable validity</i>	<i>All sources demonstrate careful consideration of validity and sources do not repeat same information</i>
<b>Accuracy – 10%</b>	<i>Makes more than 10 errors on citations</i>	<i>Makes 6-10 errors on citations</i>	<i>Makes 3-5 errors on citations</i>	<i>Includes the complete and accurate bibliographic citation for each source and is organized according to citation method used</i>
<b>Content – 30%</b>	<i>Little or no information specific to the source is included</i>	<i>One component of the annotation is missing in many citations</i>	<i>One component of the annotation is missing or very limited in several citations</i>	<i>Summaries are accurate, evaluation addresses validity of source and usefulness for assignment is included for every source</i>
<b>Structure – 25%</b>	<i>Annotations are missing or are not coherent</i>	<i>Poorly written, many generic statements, too short</i>	<i>Well written but contain some generic statements OR not appropriate length</i>	<i>Well-written, unique to the source, avoids vague statements. Appropriate length</i>
<b>Overall Quality – 20%</b>	<i>Sources used would not create an informative paper</i>	<i>Sources miss key topics required by presentation assignment</i>	<i>Bibliography provides sources to create a paper on the topic but is missing some key information</i>	<i>Bibliography could be used to generate a comprehensive research paper with excellent sources</i>
